PRESS RELEASES

CDS Arrest: On April 29, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office stopped a motor vehicle on Oxford Road near Clubhouse Drive for a moving violation. Deputies identified the driver/sole occupant of the vehicle as Jason Murray Sanchez, 47 of Easton, MD and, with the assistance of TCSO K9 Raven, developed probable cause to search the vehicle. Deputies located heroin and related paraphernalia. Sanchez was issued a criminal citations for possession of a controlled substance and possession of paraphernalia. Sanchez was released from the scene upon his signature on the citations.

Warrant Arrest: On May 2, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office arrested Jerry Francis Widener, 52 of Easton, MD. On April 20, 2022, the District Court for Talbot County issued an arrest warrant charging Widener with possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute and four counts of possession of a controlled substance. Widener was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Widener was held pending further action by the court.

Warrant Arrest: On May 2, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office arrested Jeremy Ryan Cummings, 43 of Easton, MD. On August 4, 2021, the Circuit Court for Talbot County issued two arrest warrants charging Cummings with failure to appear at a scheduled court hearing on the original charge of driving while impaired by alcohol and child support. Cummings was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Cummings was ordered held on a cash bond of \$6,000.

Vehicle Theft: On May 3, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office were informed by the owner of Gay's Seafood of a stolen trailer. Laurence "Renny" Gay reported his galvanized 2006 Road King 6X12 utility trailer, displaying MD registration 990531G, was removed from his Port Street property without permission. CDS Arrest: On May 5, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office observed a motor vehicle traveling on Black Dog Alley, leave the roadway and enter a ditch becoming stuck. Deputies identified the driver as Kyle Justin Kammer, 33 of Chester, MD. Utilizing TCSO K-9 Chief, probable cause was developed to search the vehicle. Deputies located heroin capsules and paraphernalia and placed Kammer under arrest, charging him with possession of a controlled substance and possession of paraphernalia. Kammer was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Kammer was held pending further action by the court.
