# PRESS RELEASE

The Talbot County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Division has arrested Christopher Lee Young, 39, of Royal Oak, Maryland for charges stemming from a 2020 burglary investigation. Young has been charged with:

- First Degree Burglary
- Third Degree Burglary
- Fourth Degree Burglary
- Theft: \$100 to Under \$1,500
- Malicious Destruction of Property <\$1,000
- Rifle/Shotgun Possession – Disqualification (X5)
- Illegal Possession of Ammo (X2)
- CDS: Possess Not Marijuana (Cocaine)
- CDS: Possess Not Marijuana (Heroin)
- CDS: Possess Paraphernalia (X 3)
- CDS: Possess with Intent to Distribute: Narcotic (Cocaine)
- Know Alter Firearm ID Number (X 2)
- Rifle/Shotgun: Unregistered (X 2)
- Reg. Firearm: Illegal Possession (X 2)
- CDS: POSSESS-NOT MARIJUANA (Fentanyl)
- NARC/COUNTRFIT POS W/I DIS (Counterfeit Cocaine)

On October 28, 2020, deputies with the Talbot County Sheriff's Office responded to Gates Street in Royal Oak, Maryland in reference to a burglary. Investigation revealed items including firearms had been stolen from the victim's residence.

Investigators with the Criminal Investigations Division continued the investigation. Christopher Young was developed as a suspect and a search warrant was executed at his residence in Bellevue. Evidence was recovered from the residence linking Young to the burglary. On November 20, 2020 Young was arrested by deputies with the Talbot County Sheriff's Office. Young was released on \$25,000 unsecured personal bond.

Deputies with the Talbot County Sheriff's Office continued their investigation into Young and a subsequent search warrant was executed at Young's residence in January 2021. Drugs and firearms were located during that search warrant. Deputies obtained an arrest warrant for Young based on the evidence in the subsequent search warrant. On August 4, 2022 Young was arrested by deputies with the Talbot County Sheriff's Office for several warrants stemming from this investigation and Young was held without bond. Young's case is pending further court proceedings.
