PRESS RELEASES

Warrant Arrest: On October 11, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office arrested Elizabeth Anne Daly, 25 of Cordova, MD. On October 4, 2022, the Talbot County District Court issued an arrest warrant charging Daly with failure to appear at a scheduled court hearing for driving while suspended. Daly was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Daly was held pending further action by the court.

Assault Arrest: On October 14, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office responded to the 27000 block of Jarboe Road, Easton, MD for a domestic assault. Deputies met with the victim who advised she had been assaulted by her husband. Deputies observed injuries consistent with an assault and arrested Dennis Paul Duley, 64 of Easton, MD and charged him with assault. Dennis Duley was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Duley was held pending further action by the court.

CDS Arrest: On October 16, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office stopped a motor vehicle on Black Dog Alley near E.R Harvey for a moving violation. Deputies identified the driver as Diante Dickerson, 21 of Preston, MD and developed probable cause to search the vehicle. Deputies located marijuana in a sufficient quantity to indicate distribution and paraphernalia. Dickerson was charged with possession of a controlled substance with the intent to distribute, possession of a controlled substance and paraphernalia. Dickerson was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Dickerson was held pending further action by the court.

CDS Arrest: On October 17, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office stopped a motor vehicle on Chapel Road near Black Dog Alley, Easton, MD for a moving violation. Deputies made contact with the driver and identified a passenger as Bernard DeAngelo Todd, 45 of Cambridge, MD. Deputies developed probable cause to search the vehicle. During the search, Deputies attempted to detain Todd, who fled from the scene on foot and was apprehended after a short chase. Todd was found to be in possession of controlled substances and related paraphernalia. Todd was charged with possession of a controlled substance, possession of paraphernalia, resisting arrest, fleeing and eluding, obstructing and hindering and possession of marijuana in the amount less than 10 grams. Todd was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Todd was held pending further action by the court.

Warrant Arrest: On October 18, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office arrested Leon Allan Raisin, 27 of Salisbury, MD. An arrest warrant was issued by the Talbot County District Court for failure to appear at a scheduled hearing on the original charge of malicious destruction of property. Raisin was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Raisin was held pending further action by the court.

Warrant Arrest: On October 20, 2022, Deputies from the Talbot County Sheriff's Office arrested John Morgan Flowers, 30 of Easton, MD. An arrest warrant was issued by the Talbot County District Court charging Flowers with numerous traffic violations, to include; driving on a revoked license, fleeing and eluding, reckless driving and negligent driving. Flowers was transported to the Talbot County Central Booking facility for processing and an initial appearance before a District Court Commissioner. Flowers was held pending further action by the court. Flowers has a history of driving without a license and fleeing from the police. Flowers has been involved as a suspect in twenty-one incidents in Talbot County over the last several years.
